The threat of CSAM/CSEM by generative-AI is emerging globally. In 2023 ChildFund Japan announced the publication of the results of an awareness survey on child pornography. About 70% of respondents answered "AI-generated content that involves child sexual expressions should be subject to regulation" or "should be subject to regulation somewhat." ChildFund Japan has invited the Internet Watch Foundation to discuss how we can work together to stop child sexual abuse online. ChildFund has organised a symposium for public awareness in Japan.
